



ATTENDANCE	Annual Canadians Attendance pins will be given to the first 200 entries.		
PRICES	All prices will be at regular Host Club Rates. All Shooters will be charged prevailing ATA, CTA and MTA fees. No refunds on targets and trophies, refunds for options only up to the start of the event.		
	ATA Daily Fee \$4 / MTA Daily Fee \$4 / CTA Fee \$3 (per 100 Targets) All fees are in CDN dollars.		
	Cash or checks will be accepted as payment for shooter entry. Debit or credit cards cannot be processed at this shoot for entry payment.		
	108mm Orange Dome WhiteFlyer targets will be thrown for all events.		
SHELLS	Reloads will be permitted at this tournament. A limited number of factory loaded shells will be available at prevailing prices. A valid firearms license (PAL or POL) is required to purchase ammo.		
RV PARKING	Approximately 50 RV spaces are available. Rate: \$25.00/night.

SAFETY	Safety is always our number one priority. Please review and abide by the safety rules of our host club and the ATA; ensure that this is a safe and enjoyable event for all.		
ALCOHOL	Shooters are reminded of ATA rules that prohibit consumption of alcohol or drugs during participation in any event or sub-event or between events or sub-events including shoot-offs.		



REGISTRATION	Check individual events for registration times. Only CTA Directors may classify shooters. Any shooter's classification not signed by a Director will be disqualified.
BE READY TO SHOOT	With the goal of completing the days' events in a timely manner, shooters will have 3 minutes to take the line once their squad is called.
	All Classifications, Squadding and Calculations will be done with 3S Shoot Software. Shooters are responsible to check their scores every post change. No corrections will be made outside of tallying errors, strictly within the ATA rules.
SQUADDING	Please allow enough time before the event to go through handicapping and cashiering. Preferential "late/early" squadding will be avoided, as we expect to operate with the least possible delay between events. Reasonable time will be allowed for registration before entries will be closed. If you are going to be late, please make arrangements with the Event Coordinators. Any Shooter wishing to re-squad, or misses their squad will be charged a one time re-squadding fee of \$20CAD, provided the need for re-squad is not a result or instance where the shoot management is at fault. Any shooters that are re-squadded will be placed on the same bank as their original squad.
EARNED YARDAGE	Shooters earning yardage in any Handicap event must report to the Classification Desk to have their Average Card punched.
Handicapping	All average cards must be current and averages must be calculated when being presented for classification to the handicap committee. Classification will be based on known ability, current and past averages. Shoot management reserves the right to review all scores in any singles or doubles event on day one and day two of this tournament for classification purposes. Shooters may be moved to a higher class at the discretion of shoot management.

GENERAL INFORMATION

CATEGORIES	Because All American points will be awarded at this tournament, shooters may declare only one category (i.e. Lady 1, Lady 2, Sub-Junior, Junior, Junior-Gold, Sub-Vet, Veteran, or Senior Veteran). Chair shooters are exempt from this rule. Category shooters listed above must declare their special category at the time of classification in order to be eligible for special category trophies. It is the responsibility of special category shooters to ensure that their special category has been noted on their entry form prior to cashiering for the first event entered.
CANADIANS	To classify as a Resident Shooter, you must be been born in Canada, or be a current permanent resident. Shooters must declare Residence at time of registration.
SHOOT ORDER	Singles and Handicap events will be shot 5 targets per post, 25 targets per trap. Doubles will be shot 5 pair per post, 25 pairs per trap.
BANKS	Targets in any singular event will be shot on one Bank, with two Traps per Bank. Shoot management reserves the right to modify.
MAKE UPS	All Make Ups must be completed before the end of the event. No shooter will be allowed to make up more than 50 targets, and must be witnessed by an Event Coordinator.
PRACTICE	Practice traps will be open during shoot days, 30 minutes prior to the start of any scheduled event. Practice rounds will be at regular Club rates.
CLASS ADVANCE	Shooters winning or tying for class in any singles or doubles event in the 1000 target program may be advanced at least one class for the next like event. There will be no class advances on Wednesday's Doubles Marathon. Should you earn yardage in any Handicap event, it is the shooter's responsibility to report to an Event Coordinator for yardage punch and any possible squadding revisions resulting in movement.
SHOOT OFFS	Ties in all events will carry over to the next like sub-event where possible, except Championship events. Any variation is at the discretion of shoot management. Handicap Ties will be shot off each day where yardage advances are applied to only one shooter. All Ties in the Championship events will be resolved by shoot-off as per ATA rules. Shooters are responsible for determining whether they are in a shoot-off and to report to the shoot-off when called. Shooters who fail to report on time will forfeit.



TROPHIES	Refer to the "Trophy Schedule" in this Program for specifics. Shoot management reserves the right to amend the trophy schedule for any shoot. If changes are made, they will be posted prior to beginning the event. Please claim your trophies. Trophies left behind will be recycled, not mailed.
CLOSED TIES	Where multiple Resident Shooters tie with the highest score in an event featuring Open and Closed trophies, a shoot off will determine the winne of Closed Champion. Second place will take Open Champion. If more than two Resident shooters are tied, third will take Runner Up Closed, fourth would take Runner Up Open where offered, then Closed Category then Closed Class.
ETIQUETTE	Please show courtesy to other shooters by refraining from loud or boisterous conduct while behind shooters still competing on the firing lin especially during the handicap events. Your cooperation is appreciated. The CTA and Canadian shoot management also reserve the right to disqualify, or refuse entry to any person/s or shooter/s who interfere with or disturb the harmony of the shoot in any manner. The CTA reserves the right to modify/cancel/revise any aspect of the event if necessary.
GRIEVANCES	Because the Canadian Championship tournament is hosted by a club, The CTA Board of Directors has therefore struck a committee consisting of the ATA Delegate and three others to be appointed by the CTA to be responsible for handling all shooter grievances at the tournament.
CHANGES	Every effort has been made to ensure that information in this Program is accurate and complete, however shoot management reserves the right to alter or cancel any part of this program at any time and for any reasor and are not bound by errors or omissions. Any changes and/or correction posted at the registration table/scoreboard area will supersede the information in this program.



C.T.A. Directors

CLASSIFICATION AND HANDICAPPING

Classification will be based on official averages and known ability. In all cases, known ability will have a strong bearing on classification. The CTA reserves the authority to change the classification of any shooter at any time and the additional authority through proper channels with the ATA to make any yardage change they deem necessary. CTA Delegates are the Classification and Handicap Committee for this Shoot. Any **shooter whose classification is not signed by a CTA Delegate will be disqualified**. Shooters are required to have their 16-yard and doubles averages computed prior to registration. Shooters who present an average card without all targets recorded and/ or without averages being calculated will not be classified until the card is completed. To be classified as a Resident Shooter, you must be born in Canada, or currently be a permanent resident. **Shooters must declare Residence at the time of registration**.


PENALTY CLASSIFICATION

22

- **Singles** A shooter who has less than 1000 total 16 yard targets registered for the current and previous two years will be assigned to "B" class or higher at the discretion of the CTA Director classifying the shooter.
- **Doubles** A shooter who has less than 1000 total doubles targets registered for the current and previous two years will be assigned to "B" class or higher at the direction of the CTA Director classifying the shoot.
- Handicap Subject to ATA Rule Section VI 4a.and 4b., A shooter will shoot his or her ATA or PITA yardage, whichever is the longest. It is the shooter's responsibility to notify the handicapper if he/she holds or has held a card of another trapshooting association during the current or preceding ATA target year. Sr.Vet shooters who have less than 1000 total handicap targets registered for the current and previous two years will shoot from assigned yardage or average card yardage, whichever is longer. Assigned yardage will be no less than 20 yards. All other shooters who have less than 1000 total Handicap targets registered for the current and previous two years will shoot from assigned yardage or average card yardage. Whichever is longer. Assigned yardage will be no less than 23 yards. Yardage may be re-classified if minimums are met during the tournament subject to restrictions.

PENALTY CLASSIFICATION CONT'D

Subject to penalty classification, the following classification table will be used for this tournament:



NOTICE TO SPECIAL CATEGORY SHOOTERS

Because All American points will be awarded at this tournament, shooters may declare only one category (I.e. Lady1, Lady 2, Sub-Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub-Vet, Veteran, or Senior Veteran). Chair shooters are exempt from this rule. Category shooters listed above must declare their special category at the time of classification in order to be eligible for special category trophies. It is the responsibility of special category shooters to ensure that their special category has been noted on their entry form prior to cashiering for the first event entered. Any Category Shooter tied for event Champion may shoot-off/carry over for the Championship Trophy. If the Category shooter fails in the trophy shoot-off/carry over, they will fall back to the declared Category. In an event that has no Champion Trophy, the Category shooter whose score gualifies for a trophy in their declared Category, may not fall back to place, or class. Where there is no Category Trophy offered, the Category shooter is eligible to shoot for Class trophies without forfeiting their special Category status should they lose. All American Points are not trophies. Any Category Shooter whose score does not qualify for a trophy in their category, may compete for place, or class trophies. Once declarations of Category have been made by the shooter or shoot management, the declaration is final and cannot be changed. There shall be no exception to this rule.

CANADA CAP CHALLENGE

CANADA CAP CHALLENGE RULES

- 1. No Entry Fee.
- 2. Purse Cash Prize: \$4000 (as of March 22, 2023).
- 3. The Canada Cap Challenge will be held during the Canadian Trapshooting Association Preliminary Handicap.
- 4. The top 5 scores from each ATA Province (British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, Ontario, Quebec and Atlantic Provinces) will determine the Provincial 5 Man Teams.
- 5. ATA Provinces with less than 5 shooters in attendance will merge as Team Canada and follow the standard team selection process outlined in these rules.
- 6. In the event that a Team Canada does not have 5 shooters, the remaining team members will be chosen from shooters that did not make their respective Provincial 5 Man Team. Upon the completion of shooting, and after all carry-overs / shoot-offs are finalized, the required number of shooters, selected by high score, will join Team Canada.
- 7. The team with the highest combined score will be declared the Canada Cap Challenge Champions and reserve all bragging rights associated with the title.
- 8. The Canada Cap Challenge Champions will split the Canada Cap Challenge Purse evenly.
- 9. Ties for Provincial 5 Man Team member selection and/or the Canada Cup Challenge purse prize will be determined by carry-over in the Canadian Handicap Championship.
- 10. Shooters involved in a carry-over will shoot the Canadian Handicap Championship event from their most current assigned yardage.
- 11. Carry-overs will be based on each sub event (25 targets) and continue until all ties are broken.
- 12. Ties existing after the completion of the Canadian Handicap Championship will be determined by a shoot-off until a winning team is determined.
- 13. The Canada Cap Challenge Committee will oversee the Canada Cap Challenge. All decisions are final.
