## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

### **ATTENDANCE**

Annual Canadian Attendance pins will be given to the first 250 entries.

### **CLASSIFICATION, SQUADDING & CASHIERING HOURS**

Office open Wednesday June 25 at 12pm - 6pm for classifying and squadding. On Thursday, Friday, Saturday & Sunday, the office is open 7:30am - 4pm for cashiering as well.

### **SHOOTING WILL START AT 9AM SHARP**

### **SQUADDING**

Pre-squadding is available at Presquad.com. You may pre-squad for yourself or your entire squad. The cost to pre-squad is \$1.50CAD per post, and payable through the website. All handicap squadding will be as per ATA rules. Pre-squadding is available May 1 - June 23, 2025 at midnight. Shoot management reserves the right to move shooter(s) to a different squad in order to avoid unnecessary delay during the shoot.

### **PRICES**

All prices will be at regular Host Club Rates. All shooters will be charged prevailing ATA, CTA and OPTA fees.

**ATA Daily Fee \$5.90 / OPTA \$4.50. All fees are in CDN dollars.**

### **ENTRY PAYMENT**

Cash or cheques will be accepted as payment for shooter entry. All cashied entries are final. No entries or options will be refunded unless the event is cancelled.

### **TARGETS**

108mm Euro Targets will be thrown for all events. Shoot Management, will set targets each morning or upon event changes. Targets will be set in accordance with ATA rules, using a crossbar. NO SHOOTERS ARE PERMITTED TO MOVE OR RESET TARGETS.

### **SHELLS**

Only ATA compliant ammunition will be permitted at this tournament including all reloads. A limited number of factory loaded ammunition will be available to purchase with a valid firearms license (PAL). All empty hulls on the ground become property of the HGC.



## **CAMPING**

For insurance purposes, each RV / Trailer using electrical services, is required to sign a disclaimer. No A/C is permitted. Serviced sites are \$25/day. There are no sewer sites or dump stations on site.

## **VENDORS**

All vendors require prior approval from The Hamilton Gun Club.

## **SAFETY**

Safety is always our top priority. All shooters must abide by the safety rules of the HGC and the ATA. Shoot management may disqualify any shooter for violation of these rules.

## **DRUGS & ALCOHOL**

Shooters are reminded of of ATA rules that prohibit consumption of alcohol or drugs during participation in any event or sub-event or between events or sub-events including shoot-offs, as per section IV, J of the ATA Rule Book.

## **BE READY TO SHOOT**

With a goal of completing the days' events in a timely manner, shooters are expected to be at the ready as soon as the squad before them is finished. Shooters will not be called to the line. Squads will have 3 minutes to wait for absent members, after which they must resume shooting.

## **CANADIANS**

To classify as a Resident Shooter, you must be born in Canada, or be a current permanent resident. Shooters must declare Residence at time of registration.

## **SHOOT ORDER**

Singles and Handicap events will be shot 5 targets per post, 25 targets per trap. Doubles will be shot 5 pairs per post, 25 pairs per trap.

## **BANKS**

Targets in any singular event will be shot on one Bank, with two Traps per Bank. Shoot management reserves the right to modify.

### **MAKE UPS**

All Make Ups must be completed before the end of the event. No shooter will be allowed to make up more than 50 targets, and must be witnessed by an Event Coordinator.

### **PRACTICE**

During shoot days, practice traps will be open on the east side, 30 minutes prior to the start of any scheduled event. Practice rounds will be at regular club rates. Tickets for practice rounds will be available to purchase at the cashiering office. The club will also be open on Wednesday, June 25, 2025 all day for practice of all disciplines at club rate.

### **SHOOT OFFS**

Ties in all events will carry over to the next like sub-event where possible, except Championship events. Any variation is at the discretion of shoot management. Handicap Ties will be shot off each day where yardage advances are applied to only one shooter. All ties in the Championship events will be resolved by shoot-off as per ATA rules. Shooters are responsible for determining whether they are in a shoot-off and to report to the shoot-off when called. Shooters who fail to report on time will forfeit.

### **TROPHIES**

Refer to the "Trophy Schedule" in this program for specifics. Shoot management reserves the right to amend the trophy schedule for any shoot. If changes are made, they will be posted prior to beginning the event. Please claim your trophies. Trophies left behind will be recycled, not mailed.

### **CLOSED TIES**

Where multiple Resident Shooters tie with the highest score in an event featuring Open and Closed trophies, a shoot off will determine the winner of Closed Champion. Second place will take Open Champion. If more than two Resident shooters are tied, third will take Runner Up Closed, fourth would take Runner Up Open where offered, then Closed Category, then Closed Class.



### **ETIQUETTE**

Please show courtesy to other shooters by refraining from loud or boisterous conduct while behind shooters still competing on the firing line, especially during the handicap events. Your cooperation is appreciated. The HGC shoot management also reserves the right to disqualify, or refuse entry to any person/s or shooter/s who interfere with or disturb the harmony of the shoot in any manner.

### **PAYOUTS**

All payout cheques for the shoot will be mailed after the end of the shoot.

### **SHOOT MANAGEMENT**

The Hamilton Gun Club is the official shoot management for the 2025 Canadian Trapshooting Championship shoot. Under ATA rules, the HGC will exercise all authority and have the final decision, should controversy arise.

### CANADA CAP CHALLENGE RULES

1. No Entry Fee.
2. Purse Cash Prize: \$4000
3. The Canada Cap Challenge will be held in the Canadian Trapshooting Association Preliminary Handicap (Friday's Handicap).
4. The top 5 Ontario resident scores will determine Team Ontario.
5. The top 5 non-Ontario resident scores will determine the All Provinces Team.
6. The team with the highest combined score will be declared the Canada Cap Challenge Champions and reserve all bragging rights associated with the title.
7. The Canada Cap Challenge Champions will split the Canada Cap Challenge Purse evenly.
8. A tie will be resolved by a carry-over of all team members in the Canadian Handicap Championship.
9. Shooters involved in a carry-over will shoot the Canadian Handicap Championship event from their current assigned yardage.
10. The carry-over will be based on each sub event (25 targets) and continue until the tie is broken.
11. A tie existing after the completion of the Canadian Handicap Championship will be determined by a shoot-off until a winning team is determined.
12. The Canada Cap Challenge Committee will oversee the Canada Cap Challenge. All decisions are final.

# CLASSIFICATION

## CLASSIFICATION COMMITTEE

## CLASSIFICATION AND HANDICAPPING

---

Classification will be based on official averages and known ability. The CTA reserves the authority to change the classification of any shooter at any time and the additional authority through proper channels with the ATA to make any yardage change they deem necessary. CTA delegates are the Classification and Handicap Committee for this shoot.

### TARGET REQUIREMENTS

**SINGLES:** Any shooter with fewer than 1000 16-yard targets in the current and previous target year combined will be placed in CLASS B or higher.

**HANDICAP:** Any shooter with fewer than 1000 handicap targets in the current and previous target year combined will be handicapped at 23 yards, or in their current handicap yardage (whichever is greater). Shooters with an established yardage who do not meet target requirements may shoot from their established yardage for “targets only”, forfeiting all options, purses, trophies, or added money.

**DOUBLES:** Any shooter with fewer than 700 doubles targets over the current and previous target year combined will be placed in CLASS B or higher.

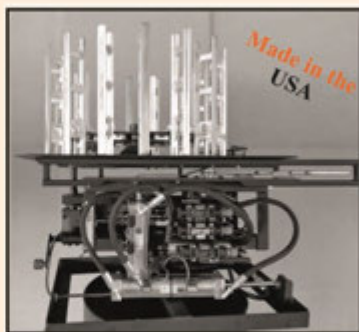

<b>LADY I:</b>	a female shooter who has not reached their 55th birthday
<b>LADY II:</b>	a female shooter who has reached their 55th birthday
<b>SUB-VETERAN:</b>	a shooter who is 55 but has not reached their 65th birthday
<b>VETERAN:</b>	a shooter who is 65 but has not reached their 70th birthday
<b>SENIOR VET:</b>	a shooter who is 70 or older.

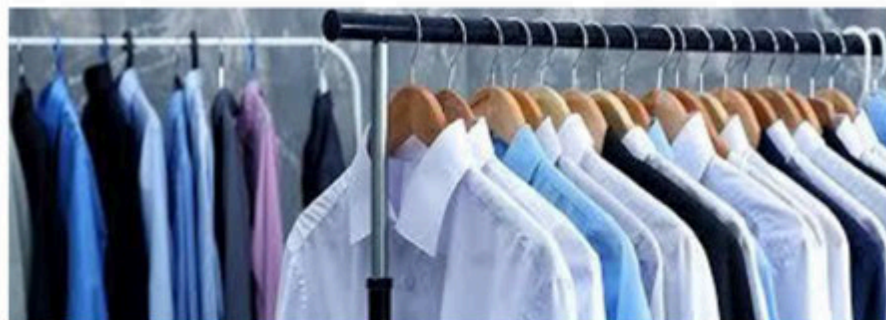
